The Department of Environmental Quality understands the need for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification - Modification to the above referenced project. This modification will include the use of 2.5:1 slope along the rear curb that will allow for approximately 2' of additional fill at the rear of the site. Along the west side, the required tie back slopes of 2:1 will stay with the footprint of original wetland impacts. The change in slopes will not increase impacts to the wetlands in this project area. The slopes in the project area shall not be any steeper than 2:1 as stated in the letter emailed to our office on June 11, 2018. Please be advised condition 1 of the Section 401 Water Quality Certification has been modified to read as follows:

1. The slopes in the project area shall not be any steeper than 2:1 as stated in the letter emailed to our office on June 11, 2018.
