The Department of Environmental Quality understands the need for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification - Modification to the above referenced project. In this modification, the authorized project design will not impact 0.07 acres of the previously permitted area. Instead, an additional 0.04 acre will be filled in two new areas for the Carmax facility in Gulfport. These changes are denoted in red on the plans for construction project, MSR107843. Please be advised Condition 4 of the Section 401 Water Quality Certification has been modified to read as follows:

1. The final post-construction Storm Water Management Plan, submitted by Brown and Mitchell, Incorporated June 4, 2007, subsequent submittal dated October 11, 2018.
