In response to your letter dated March 31, 2016 giving 60 days to respond and supply documentation. Lamar County has adjusted the proposed five year program. Included in this reply to the permit review comments letter is this letter addressing the itemized points made, the revised Storm Water Program, the Form A for coverage of larger sites.

The Notice of Re-Coverage has been provided along with the Program documentation, and additional information for reference and clarification purposes. Lamar County understands the stipulations of the new permit cycle and will begin to implement the additional measures as the capability arises prior to the end of the permit cycle. Lamar County is going to operate as the permit cycle began in 2016 and ends 5 full years from that point.

Lamar County finds no changes from its previous request, that all sites over 5 acres continue to be permitted through MDEQ and its divisions. The additional burden would place a strain on the County that we feel we would not be able to actionably take on task wise at this time. This consideration is being made as part of the Construction Minimum Measure Assistance program.
