Introduction




Figure 1. Survey Area. Base Map: USGS Trinity 7.5' topographic quadrangle, 1987.

At the request of Mr. Bob Phillips of Phillips Contracting, I have performed a cultural resources survey of a proposed mine area in Lowndes County. The total proposed new mine area is approximately 45 acres in area and surrounds the existing 10 acre +/- Cox Lake Mine opened under Permit 05-022. The limits of the proposed Pilkinton Mine are shown in Figure 1, based on the Trinity and Columbus South 7.5' topographic quadrangles. Most of the survey area is located in the East half of the Northeast Quarter, Section 5, Township 17 North, Range 18 East, but a sliver of the northernmost part extends into the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, Section 32, Township18 North, Range 18 East.

Shovel testing located one archaeological site within the survey area. This has been named the Pilkinton Mine site, and assigned site number 22Lo1032 by the Historic Preservation Division of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History (MDAH-HP). While the site appears to cover a relatively large area, it is not considered significant because it appears to have been heavily plowed and eroded and also has a low density of materials.
