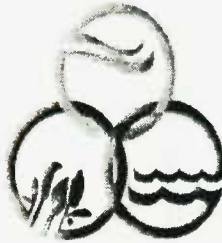

## INSTRUCTIONS

The submittal of this form is required to receive coverage under the reissued Baseline General Permit. This form must be completed and returned to the address printed at the bottom of page 2 within 30 days of the date of the Letter of Instruction for Re-Coverage.

The signatory of this form must be the owner or operator who is the current coverage recipient (rather than the plant/site manager or environmental consultant). The coverage recipient is responsible for permit compliance.

Amendments to the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) are required to be attached if the plan is not current or is ineffective in controlling storm water pollutants. The visual assessment and training sections of your SWPPP will probably need to be updated to adhere to permit requirements (see ACT8, S-1 and ACT12, S-1 and S-2). These updates do NOT need to be submitted to MDEQ.

If the facility is out of business or no longer a regulated facility, please request termination of coverage by completing the Request for Termination (RFT) Form found in the Baseline Forms Package. Facilities that continue to discharge wastewater without applicable permit coverage are in violation of state law.

Do not submit this form if submitting a "Request for Termination" (RFT).

Do not submit this form if submitting a "No Exposure Certification."


## Addendum to MASA Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan

I, Jimmy Staring, would like to offer this addendum to BMP  
2.

It is my opinion that removing all fluids from incoming vehicles is a waste of labor, time, and shop space. It also increases the likelihood of spilling processed fluids which could be absorbed into the ground or washed into drains or streams.

We primarily purchase vehicles that are 4 years old and older. These vehicles have been involved in an accident, moved to a wrecker lot, transferred to an insurance holding facility, and finally, we get the vehicle. The fluids have not leaked in this amount of time and with all this movement, so why open it now? I do not understand the benefit of opening a part that does not leak. If one of these parts were damaged in the accident, in all likelihood the fluid has leaked out before we get the vehicle.

The area that we store our vehicles on prior to dismantling is flat. When we move the vehicle, we take a look on the ground for signs of leaks. If we detect fluid on the ground, we remove it at this time.
