The Permit Board on Environmental Quality reissued the Mining Storm Water, Dewatering, and No Discharge General Permit (MSR32) on September 7, 2012. A Letter of Instruction and associated forms dated September 12, 2012 were mailed to permitted sites statewide with instructions detailing how the mining site could remain covered under an active permit.

The Letter of Instruction required specific actions and provided thirty (30) days to respond. The 30-day response period ended on October 12, 2012. As of the date of this letter, MDEQ has not received a response regarding the above referenced site. In order for the above referenced site to remain covered under a valid permit, the enclosed Re-coverage Form must be completed and returned to the indicated address by January 20, 2013.

Permit coverage must be terminated if the mining site is out of business, or is no longer active. A Request for Termination of Coverage Form is enclosed. If the mining site has been purchased by a third party, please forward this package to the new owner and contact Mike Noone.

If mining activities are ongoing and the coverage recipient does not apply for re-coverage, you will be operating without a valid permit and will be subject to enforcement action.
