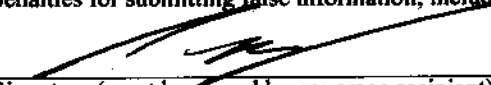



Sir/Madam:

Enterprise Gas Processing, LLC (Enterprise) submits herein to the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) a request for major modification to the Hydrostatic Test General Permit No. MSG130499 (Permit) at the above referenced facility. The following attachments are enclosed:

- MDEQ Major Modification Form For Hydrostatic Test General Permit MG13;
- Updated MDEQ Outfall Information Form; and
- Updated USGS Topographic Map.

Enterprise is requesting modification of the Permit to update coordinates for existing Outfalls 001 and 003. Coordinates listed in the Notice of Intent submitted on November 23, 2016 for these two outfalls are being updated for accuracy; no additional outfalls or physical changes to the existing outfalls are being requested. In addition, the receiving stream is being updated for each of the outfalls authorized to discharge hydrostatic test water by this Permit. It was determined that the accurate receiving stream for the existing outfalls is Bayou Casotte. Bayou Casotte is listed on the Final MDEQ 2016 303(d) list as being impaired for organic enrichment / low dissolved oxygen and there is a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) for Phenol. The Facility has employed various Best Management Practices (BMPs), and Enterprise is not aware of any sources of phenol from its operations. The implementation of existing BMPs is expected to be adequate to control the intermittent discharges of hydrostatic test water and prohibit further impairment of the designated and/or beneficial uses of the receiving stream.
