Georgia-Pacific WFS LLC (GP) requests the removal of Outfall 003 from the NPDES permit for GP's Meridian Wet Deck facility.

During the permit transfer requested in March of 2019, GP identified Outfall 002 as the only discharge location at the facility. Outfall 003 was previously identified under the prior permit owner; however, Outfall 003 does not discharge from the site and instead flows directly to Outfall 002.
