Facilities that continue to discharge wastewater without applicable permit coverage are in violation of state law.

to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended by the Clean Water Act (CWA) (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.), and codified in 40 CFR 122. The operations conducted at the OmniSource Southwest facility are classified under Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Code 5093, "Scrap and Waste Materials," which is defined as establishments primarily engaged in assembling, breaking up, sorting, and distributing scrap and waste materials. Specifically, the facility is a ferrous and nonferrous metal recycler.

Mississippi is a delegated state with NPDES permitting authority. The state's NPDES program is administered by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). Mississippi storm water regulations for storm water discharges associated with industrial activity are codified in the Mississippi Code of 1972, and set forth in the Mississippi Water Pollution Control Law, 49-47-1 et seq., as amended, and the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality Regulation WPC-1, Wastewater Regulations for National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permits, Underground Injection Control (UIC) Permits, State Permits, Water Quality Based Effluent Limitations and Water Quality Certification. OmniSource Southwest is covered under Mississippi's Baseline Storm Water General Permit for Industrial Activities (MSR00). The general permit is included as Appendix A. Table 1-1 summarizes permit requirements.
