

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your Notice of Exempt Operation received on March 15, 2021. <u>In the event this operation exceeds four (4) acres, you will be required to obtain a state mining permit.</u>

In addition to a Notice of Exempt Operation, you must apply for and obtain coverage under a Mining Storm Water General NPDES Permit prior to any mining activities at this site. Operating without a Storm Water Permit is a violation of the Mississippi State Law, Sections 49-17-1 through 49-17-43, which provides for significant monetary penalties.
