For new or expanding facilities, detailed plans and specifications must be submitted for the wet deck log spray recirculation pond(s) by a registered Professional Engineer. Also, contiguous landowner notification forms, the proof of publication in a local newspaper, and the acceptance letter from a local library must also be provided as outlined in Activity 4, Conditions S-2 and S-3 of the general permit.

As part of this NOI, if applicable, all previously approved boiler chemical additive approval notifications must be submitted. At a minimum, the exact name of the chemical, the date of the facility's notification submittal, and MDEQ's approval letter must be provided.

If the company seeking permit coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, then attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of this submittal. Coverage will be issued to the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

Winston Plywood and Veneer LLC, Laydown Facility (Winston Plywood) has retained the services of Environmental Compliance & Safety, Inc. to prepare the necessary forms for coverage under the Wet Deck Log Spray General Permit. Information regarding the facility name, contact, SIC code, latitude/longitude of the facility, and outfalls covered by this general permit have been included in the Notice of Intent (NOI) form found in Attachment II. The site location map and wet deck log spray recirculation pond specifications are provided as Attachment III. Since siting of the wet deck system is within 150 feet from the nearest adjoining property line, Property Line Buffer Zone Waiver Forms and Quitclaim Property Deeds for acquired adjoining properties are included in Attachment III. Proof of contiguous landowner notifications, the public notice, and the library form are included in Attachment IV. In addition, Proof of Registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State is provided as Attachment V.

This project will disturb approximately 2.1 acres and, therefore, will also be subject to the Small Construction Storm Water Requirements. The Small Construction Notice of Intent (NOI), Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), any relevant notifications, and the weekly inspections will be kept on file at the facility.
