The Permit Board on Environmental Quality reissued the Wet Deck Log Spray General Permit (WDLSP - MSG17) on March 1, 2022. This permit replaces the previous general permit which was scheduled to expire on June 30, 2022. The permit is reissued for a five-year period that will end on February 28, 2027. This permit covers the State of Mississippi and will authorize discharges from wet deck log spray facilities with recirculation systems. The permit may also include boiler blowdown, exterior equipment wash waters, vehicle wash waters, and discharges of storm water exposed to industrial activities and allowable non-storm water discharges that do not drain to and discharge from the WDLSP recirculation pond.

The reissued general permit contains several changes from the previous permit which are summarized in an addendum available at <https://www.mdeq.ms.gov/wdlsgp/>. This addendum is only a summary of significant changes and does not negate the requirement for the coverage recipient to carefully read and be familiar with the permit, all of its conditions, and the updated WDLSP forms. The WDLSP and associated forms are available on MDEQ's website at: <https://www.mdeq.ms.gov/wdlsgp/>. If a coverage recipient does not have internet access, MDEQ will mail the current general permit and standardized forms upon request.

If the company seeking permit coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, then a proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing must be attached to the Recovery Form. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of the Recovery Form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

A facility granted coverage under the previous general permit has three options: (1) recoverage under the reissued general permit, (2) termination of general permit coverage, or (3) application submittals for an individual wastewater permit and if necessary coverage(s) under different general permit(s) for storm water discharges. Please read the following instructions carefully.

1. **Recovery:** In order for the Wet Deck Log Spray operation to remain covered under a valid general permit, the enclosed Recovery Form must be completed and submitted to MDEQ within 60 days of the date of this letter. An up-to-date Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) must be submitted with the recovery form if there are discharges of storm water exposed to industrial activities and allowable non-storm water discharges that do not drain to and discharge from the WDLs recirculation pond.
2. **Termination:** To terminate coverage the coverage recipient must submit the "Notice of Termination (NOT)" form which is available online at: <https://www.mdeq.ms.gov/wdlsgp/>. A Closure Plan and all previously due Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) must be completed and submitted before coverage can be terminated. The submittal of the Recovery Form is not required if a NOT form is submitted. Until receipt of written termination of coverage from MDEQ, the facility must continue to comply with the conditions of its previous general permit coverage.
3. **Applications for Individual Permits:** In the event the coverage recipient chooses to obtain individual permits, please contact MDEQ as described below to discuss the necessary applications.

MDEQ encourages facilities to submit the Recovery Form, NOT, and related forms electronically by following the instructions available at <https://www.mdeq.ms.gov/wdlsgp/>. If a SWPPP is required it may be submitted online but MDEQ also requires a hard copy be mailed to our office for our files. The facility must continue to follow the conditions of the previous permit until a current certificate of coverage is issued. An updated certificate of permit coverage will be issued when the facility satisfies recovery requirements. The updated certificate of permit coverage or confirmation of termination will be emailed or mailed to the facility.

If regulated activities are ongoing and the coverage recipient does not apply for recovery under this general permit or for individual permits, the facility will be operating without a valid permit and is subject to potential enforcement action. WET DECK LOG SPRAY GENERAL PERMIT (WDLSP) RECOVERAGE FORM

INSTRUCTIONS

All questions must be answered for this Recoverage Form to be considered complete. If an item does not apply, enter "N/A" for not applicable to show that you considered the question.

The applicant must be the owner and/or operator of the property (i.e., the legal entity that controls the facility's operation, rather than the plant/site manager or environmental consultant).

Registration with Mississippi Secretary of State: If the company seeking coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, attach proof of registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or the Certificate of Good Standing (official or unofficial copy). This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within 12 months of the date of the submittal of this coverage form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

Submittal Requirements: For recoverage under this general permit, this form must be completed and returned to MDEQ **within 60 days** of the date of the Letter of Instruction for Recoverage. For other NOI submittal deadlines see Condition S-3 of ACT 2, of the WDLSP. All forms must be submitted online at www.mdeq.ms.gov/wdlsgp or via hard copy to:

Storm Water from Industrial Activities and the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP): Discharges of storm water exposed to industrial activities and allowable non-storm water discharges identified in ACT 1, T-2(6), that do not drain to and discharge from the WDLSP recirculation pond that were previously covered under the Industrial Stormwater General Permit (ISGP) are now covered under this GP. A SWPPP for these industrial storm water discharges must be submitted with the Recoverage Form. If an electronic copy is submitted, a hard copy should also be mailed to the address above for MDEQ's files.

Storm Water from Construction Activities: Construction activities including clearing, excavating, and other land disturbing activities equal to or greater than one (1) acre but less than five (5) acres require compliance with the Small Construction General Permit and completion of a Small Construction Notice of Intent (SCNOI). Construction activities equal to or greater than five (5) acres require compliance with the Large Construction General Permit and submittal of a Large Construction Notice of Intent (LCNOI). These General Permits, NOIs, and other required forms can be found at the following link: www.mdeq.ms.gov/generalpermits/.

Notice of Termination: If the facility is out of business or no longer active, please request termination of coverage by completing the Notice of Termination (NOT) Form found at www.mdeq.ms.gov/wdlsgp. Facilities that continue to discharge wastewater and/or stormwater without applicable permit coverage are in violation of state law. This Recoverage Form is not required to be submitted if the facility is submitting a request for termination of coverage.
