INSTRUCTIONS

Coverage recipients shall notify the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality at least 30 days in advance of the following activities (check all that apply). This form should be submitted with a modified Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), updated USGS topographic map, Corps of Engineers Section 404 documentation and wastewater collection and treatment information, as appropriate.

- Facility operations are proposed to change.
- "Footprint" identified in the original ISNOI is proposed to be enlarged.
- Stormwater Quality BMPs are proposed to be modified.

This form must be signed by the current coverage recipient under Mississippi's Industrial Stormwater General Permit, an attached SWPPP must be included, and documentation of the changes compared to the previous approved SWPPP are attached.

Coverage recipients are authorized to discharge storm water associated with proposed new operations, additional areas of activity, or modified BMPs, under the conditions of the General Permit, only upon receipt of written notification of approval by MDEQ. All other modifications must be in accordance with ACT9, S-1 (6) and S-2 (7) of the General Permit.

Kimberly-Clark Corporation, Corinth Mill (K-C) retained the services of Environmental Compliance & Safety, Inc. (ECS) to prepare a Major Modification Form for the Industrial Storm Water General Permit coverage and a revised Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) to address new operations at the K-C facility which include the addition of a new process line known as CM6 (SABEL Process), CM7 (SMS Process), and a new access road. A Major Modification Form for Industrial Storm Water General Permit is enclosed as Attachment I, and a revised SWPPP is enclosed as Attachment II. These documents address operational changes, footprint changes, and Best Management Practice (BMP) changes.

The construction activities required for these modifications are covered under the Large Construction General Permit. On February 24, 2020, K-C received storm water coverage, MSR108132, for activities associated with the construction of CM6 (SABEL process) on approximately six (6) acres adjacent to the existing K-C facility. On October 22, 2020, that coverage was modified to incorporate construction activities for an additional project known as CM7 (SMS Process) and a new access road to be located on approximately fourteen (14) acres.
