Letter of Instruction for Mining GP Re-Coverage

Ref. No. MSR320479

Desoto County

The Permit Board on Environmental Quality reissued the Mining Stormwater, Dewatering, and No Discharge General Permit (MSR32) on April 3, 2018 for an additional five-year period. The Mining General Permit authorizes the discharge of mining storm water and dewatering discharges to State waters, and operation of wastewater recirculation systems with no discharge. The permit is reissued for a five-year period until March 31, 2023.

The above referenced facility has coverage under the previous general permit which expired on August 31, 2017. This facility must satisfy applicable requirements by obtaining re-coverage under the reissued general permit, or choosing one of the other alternative options outlined below.

To view the new permit and forms package, please visit https://www.mdeq.ms.gov/permits/environmental-permits-division/types-on-general-permits/. Please read the permit carefully as conditions have changed. Be especially aware of the following changes:

- Annual inspections are no longer submitted annually. They must still be available upon request.
- DMR requirements have been updated to require electronic submittal through NetDMR.

Current coverage recipients under the Mining General Permit have two options: re-coverage or termination. Please read the following instructions carefully.

- In order for the above referenced facility to remain covered under a valid NPDES Permit, the coverage recipient must complete the enclosed "Re-coverage Form" and send it to the indicated address, postmarked within 30 days of the date of this letter.
- Coverage must immediately be terminated if the discharge has ceased. A "Request for Termination of Coverage Form" is found in the "Mining GP Forms Package." The submittal of the "Re-coverage Form" is not required if a "Request for Termination of Coverage Form" is submitted.

If the company seeking permit coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, then attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of the application(s). Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

A new Certificate of Permit Coverage will not be mailed to the coverage recipient. Coverage recipients should access and print their Certificate of Coverage from the MDEQ website by following the steps listed below. Please allow at least 60 days from the submittal of the "Re-Coverage Form" before attempting to access the new Certificate of Coverage. This will give MDEQ time to complete the review and administrative process of re-coverage.

- 1. Access enSearch Online at http://opc.deq.state.ms.us/search_ai_alt.aspx and input the appropriate nine-digit coverage number (MSR32____) in the Permit Number query box. The project's unique coverage number can be found in the subject heading of this letter. Click on the "Search" button.
- 2. The regulated entity corresponding with the entered coverage number will be displayed in the table under "Results:" click on the AI ID Number in the far left column to access the facility information page, which contains online documents, re-coverage status, and specific MDEQ contacts.
- 3. Scroll to the bottom of the page and locate the table entitled, "Current Status of General Permit Applications." If this table has a status description of "Coverage Issued" then the "Permit Document" should be the new Certificate of Coverage.
- 4. Scroll up one table to locate, "Active Coverages Available Online".
- 5. Locate the project's coverage number and left-click on the file icon under the "Permit Document" column to open and print the Certificate of Permit Coverage. Please check the lower left corner of the certificate to confirm that the expiration date reads, March 31, 2023.

If a coverage recipient does not have access to the internet, MDEQ will mail a certificate of coverage upon request. Please keep a copy of the signed and completed "Re-Coverage Form" as proof of coverage until the certificate of coverage can be obtained. Also, in the case of a request for termination, written confirmation will be sent to the facility after a site inspection has been completed. Please remember that coverage is not terminated until notified in writing by MDEQ. If regulated activities are ongoing and the coverage recipient does not apply for re-coverage, the facility will be operating without a valid permit and is subject to potential enforcement action. 
