
Re: Large Construction Acreage Limitation
NPDES Permit No. MSR109223

We are submitting this request for an increase in the total allowable disturbed acreage for Project Runway from 50 acres to 150 acres. The Paccar Inc. Project Runway MSR109223 is a 500+ acre site, and due to the size, topography and quantity of soils required to be moved, the current 50-acre disturbance limitation will impact not only the construction schedule but require soil to be moved multiple times. By increasing the disturbed acreage, we will be able to streamline the initial mass grading of the project, maintain the production schedule and minimize the amount of time and exposure of disturbed soils. As a result of the increased total disturbed acreage, we will modify the SWPPP and add additional environmental controls and inspections as needed to minimize environmental impact to the surrounding area.

This request is based on language in the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality's (MDEQ) Large Construction Storm Water General Permit MSR100000, ACT5 T-8 (H) which allows the permittee to have additional disturbance with provided justification and additional controls to minimize erosion and sedimentation: "With written justification demonstrating why the project requires fifty (50) acres or more of disturbed area and additional controls to minimize erosion and sedimentation, the permittee may be allowed to disturb additional areas."

We appreciate your consideration of this request to allow us to expedite completion of this large construction project in a cost effective and environmentally friendly way.
