### AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Mississippi Rail Car, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated January 30, 2014, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations at its facility located at 4115 Highway 19 South, Meridian, Mississippi in Lauderdale County:

A. Violation of § 40 CFR 122.26(c), Application requirements for storm water discharges associated with industrial activity and storm water discharges associated with small construction activity-(1) Individual application.

Dischargers of storm water associated with industrial activity and with small construction activity are required to apply for an individual permit or seek coverage under a promulgated storm water general permit.

Respondent had a Construction Stormwater permit but had not submitted permit application for the required Baseline Stormwater permit for operation.

B. Violation of 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 6, R. 1.1.1 B - Any person proposing a discharge of wastes to waters of the State or proposing a treatment works from which no discharge of wastes is designed to occur shall file an application in the case of an individual NPDES, UIC, or State permit, at least 180 days prior to the commencement of the activity or, in the case of NOI for coverage under an issued NPDES general permit or coverage under an issued State general permit, in accordance with a schedule established in such permit.

Process wastewater, containing high levels of BOD, from the railcar cleaning had been discharged along with stormwater on numerous occasions without the required discharge permit.

By letter dated February 6, 2014, Respondent alleged to have implemented corrective measures that have resulted in return to compliance with violation B.1.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$17,750. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

B. Respondent shall develop and implement a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), and submit an application for Baseline Stormwater permit coverage within fourteen (14) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ

ALID 37117 ENF20140002 Executive Director. The SWPPP shall be developed according to the guidelines set in EPA's document number EPA-833-B-09-002 "Developing Your Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan – A Guide for Industrial Operators."

3.

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

4.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
