AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Torque Converters Inc, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated April 2, 2013, February 6, 2014, May 14, 2014, and September 17, 2014; Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations at its facility located at One TCI Drive, Ashland, Mississippi in Benton County:

- A. From October 1 to December 31, 2012, the average monthly ammonia nitrogen concentration of 3.0 mg/L exceeded the permitted limit of 2.0 mg/L by 50%.
- B. From July 1 to September 30, 2013, the average monthly ammonia nitrogen concentration of 17.7 mg/L exceeded the permitted limit of 2.0 mg/L by 785%.
- C. From October 1 to December 31, 2013, the average monthly ammonia nitrogen concentration of 34 mg/L exceeded the permitted limit of 2.0 mg/L by 1,600%.
- D. From January 1 to March 31, 2014, the average monthly ammonia nitrogen concentration of 42.7 mg/L exceeded the permitted limit of 2.0 mg/L by 2,035%.
- E. From April 1 to June 30, 2014, the average monthly ammonia nitrogen

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concentration of 17.6 mg/L exceeded the permitted limit of 2.0 mg/L by 780%.

By letters dated December 10, 2013, April 18, 2014, and September 30, 2014, Respondent alleged to have implemented corrective action measures that have resulted in a return to compliance with the applicable permits and regulations.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$6,250. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

4.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
