### AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Hybrid Plastics Inc, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated February 4, 2014, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations:

- A. Respondent failed to properly label accumulation containers with the words "hazardous waste" on numerous drums. 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 3, Ch. 1
- B. Respondent failed to properly mark the date that accumulation started on numerous drums. 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 3, Ch. 1
- C. Respondent stored hazardous wastes in excess of 90 days and is therefore storing hazardous waste without a permit. 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 3, Ch. 1
- D. Respondent failed to conduct weekly inspections of the 90 day storage area. 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 3, Ch. 1
- E. Respondent failed to provide adequate hazardous waste training for employees who manage hazardous wastes. 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 3, Ch. 1
- F. Respondent failed to provide adequate security for the storage of hazardous wastes. 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 3, Ch. 1

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$15,000. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Respondent has developed and implemented a Hazardous Waste Management System for achieving and maintaining compliance with all hazardous waste generator requirements.

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

4.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an
