AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and H E Mosley, Inc., Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated April 6, 2015, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of its failure to timely submit the calendar year 2014 annual report for its Class I rubbish site located at 1400 Willow Lake Road, Meridian, Mississippi in Lauderdale County. Failure to submit this report by February 28, 2015 is a violation of 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 4, R. 1.6.E (17) of the Mississippi Nonhazardous Solid Waste Management Regulations ("Regulation") and ACT 7, S-1 of Permit No. SWMGP R1-092 ("Permit").

2.

Respondent subsequently submitted the 2014 annual report to MDEQ on March 20, 2015.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

- A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$8,000. Respondent shall pay the first of two installments in the amount of \$3,000 to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director, or his designee (the "Effective Date"). Respondent shall pay the second installment in the amount of \$3,000 within ninety (90) days after the Effective Date.
- B. Complainant shall hold in abeyance, and Respondent shall not be required to pay, the remaining penalty balance of \$2,000 (the "Abeyance Amount") pending Respondent's compliance with 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 4, R. 1.6.E (17) of the Regulation and ACT 7, S-1 of the Permit for one (1) calendar year, set to commence upon the Effective Date. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this section, the Abeyance Amount shall become due and payable within forty-five (45) days of the Respondent receiving written notification from MDEQ.

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEO or the

Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
