## AGREED ORDER

ORDER NO.

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Norbord Industries Inc., Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated November 13, 2014, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations at its facility located at 1194 Highway 145, Guntown, Mississippi in Lee County:

- A. Failure to conduct weekly equipment inspections. Weekly equipment inspections were missed intermittently from January 2012 to September 2014.

- B. Failure to conduct monthly inspections for Visible Emissions and Visible
   Emissions Evaluations (VEE) for all equipment with the exception of the Wafer
   Drying System (Emission Point AA-001). Monthly inspections for Visible

Emissions and Visible Emissions Evaluations were not conducted in December 2013 and April 2014. {Title V Operating Permit No. 1540-00058, Pages 27-28, Condition 5.B.9}

C. Failure to monitor and record pressure drop readings for all baghouses on a daily basis. Daily monitoring and recordkeeping of pressure drop readings for the baghouses were missed intermittently from January 2012 to September 2014. 

[Title V Operating Permit No. 1540-00058, Pages 29-30, Condition 5.B.13]

As of October 29, 2015, Respondent alleges that all the violations listed above have been corrected. With regard to Item 1.B., Respondent provided weekly equipment inspection records indicating the pollution control devices in question (i.e. those required to have visual emissions inspections) were checked during the months of December 2013 and April 2014. Complainant acknowledges that Respondent conducted substitute monitoring. Respondent provided assurances that all future visual emissions inspections will be conducted and documented as required by the permit by either facility personnel or a third party contractor.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$18,500.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

The parties agree that, by entering into this Agreed Order and agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth herein, Respondent does not admit any of the allegations listed above and nothing contained herein shall be in any way construed as an admission of liability by Respondent. Without admitting any liability, Respondent consents to entry of this Agreed Order, which the parties agree shall serve as the full resolution of the violations alleged above. The parties further agree that the Commission continues to assert that the matters set forth above were violations of the environmental laws, regulations and/or permits applicable to Respondent.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing

before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
