## AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Joe McGee Construction Co., Inc. Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

Respondent is the Prime Contractor for the City of Pearl, MS Highway 477 West Rankin Parkway construction project (STP-7334-00(007)).

2.

By letter dated September 17, 2015, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following alleged violations of Mississippi Large Construction Storm Water General Permit Certificate of Coverage MSR106284 at the City of Pearl, MS Highway 477 West Rankin Parkway construction project located in, Pearl, Mississippi in Rankin County:

- A. Violation of ACT6 S-1 (1): Failure to implement the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP).
  - "The coverage recipient shall: (1) Implement the site-specific SWPPP..."
- B. Violation of ACT6 S-2 (9): Failure to maintain erosion and sediment controls.
  - "(9) Erosion and sediment controls shall be maintained at all times."

C. Violation of ACT6 S-4 (1): Failure to conduct weekly inspections.

"INSPECTION REQUIREMENT: Inspection of all receiving streams (if feasible), outfalls, erosion and sediment controls and other SWPPP requirements shall be performed during permit coverage using a copy of the form provided in the Large Construction Forms Package, and inspections shall be performed by qualified personnel:

(1) At least weekly for a minimum of four inspections per month..."

On February 19, 2016, MDEQ staff performed a follow up site visit to the City of Pearl, MS Highway 477 West Rankin Parkway construction project. This site visit determined that the project was in compliance on the day of the visit with the terms and conditions of Mississippi Large Construction Storm Water General Permit Certificate of Coverage MSR106284.

3.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$15,150. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for

future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

6.

The parties agree that, by entering into this Agreed Order and agreeing to the terms and conditions set forth herein, Respondent does not admit any of the allegations listed above and nothing contained herein shall be in any way construed as an admission of liability by Respondent. Without admitting any liability, Respondent consents to entry of this Agreed Order, which the parties agree shall serve as the full resolution of the violations alleged above. The parties further agree that the Commission continues to assert that the matters set forth above were violations of the environmental laws, regulations and/or permits applicable to Respondent.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
