AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Goodloe Construction, LLC, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

Respondent was the designated Prime Contractor for the Clover Valley subdivision construction project covered under Large Construction Storm Water General Permit Certificate of Coverage MSR106978. By letter dated April 13, 2016, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations of Mississippi Large Construction Storm Water General Permit discovered during a Compliance Evaluation Inspection conducted at the Clover Valley subdivision construction project located at Wild Rose Lane and Clover Valley Boulevard, Brandon, Mississippi in Rankin County:

- A. Violation of ACT6 S-1 (1): Failure to implement the site specific SWPPP.
- B. Violation of ACT6 S-2 (9): Failure to perform maintenance of erosion and sediment controls.

Subsequent to an Administrative Conference held on June 14, 2016, Respondent provided

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information demonstrating that the SWPPP had been implemented and that maintenance on the erosion and sediment controls had been performed. A review of the information provided and a site visit to the Clover Valley construction project by MDEQ staff determined that the corrective actions taken appeared to be sufficient to return the project site to compliance with Mississippi's Large Construction Storm Water General Permit Conditions.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

- A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,500. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before

the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
