AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and River City Dirtworks LLC and Robert W. Keyes, Jr., Individually, Respondents, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated May 12, 2015, Respondents were contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations of GP-Construction Coverage No. MSR106834 and GP-Mining Coverage No. MSR322433, at its facilities located off North Washington Street, Vicksburg. Mississippi in Warren County:

- A. Violation of ACT 6 Section S-1 of the GP-Construction Permit ("Construction Permit") regarding the failure to implement the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) as submitted;
- B. Violation of ACT 6 Section S-2 of the Construction Permit for failure to maintain all controls;

- C. Violation of ACT 6 Section S-1 of the Construction Permit regarding Implementation Requirements;
- D. Violation of ACT6, Condition S-1 (1) of the GP-Mining Permit ("Mining Permit") for Failure to implement the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan as approved;
- E. Violation of ACT6, Condition No. S-3 of the Mining Permit for failure to properly mark the area boundaries;
- F. Violation of ACT6, Condition No. S-4 of the Mining Permit for failure to ensure that the SWPPP is in compliance with all local storm water ordinances; and
- G. Violation of ACT9, L-1 of the Mining Permit for failure to ensure that water discharges were free from eroded soils.

2.

An inspection conducted and documented by MDEQ staff on February 8, 2016 indicated that Respondents were in compliance with GP-Mining Coverage MSR322433 and GP-Construction Coverage MSR106834.

3.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondents agree to settle this matter as follows:

Respondents agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$15,000. Respondents shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondents fail to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondents for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondents understand and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
