AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Alliance Consulting Group LLC, Picayune Frac Plant, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated April 9, 2012, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violation discovered during a Compliance Evaluation Inspection conducted by MDEQ staff on March 2, 2012, at its facility located at 130 B Street, Picayune, Mississippi in Pearl River County;

:

- A. Violation of MS Code Ann. 49-17-29 (2.b): Respondent failed to obtain coverage under Mississippi's Large Construction Storm Water General Permit before commencement of land disturbing activities associated with construction of the Respondent's recycling center.

On April 24, 2012, Large Construction General Permit, Certificate of Coverage No.

MSR106120 was issued to Alliance Consulting Group LLC, Picayune Frac Plant. A follow up inspection was conducted on May 9, 2012, by MDEQ staff. The inspection determined that the site specific Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) had been implemented and storm water sediment controls were operating as designed. Inspections were also being conducted and recorded by Respondent as required by the Large Construction General Permit.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violation listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

- A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$15,000.00 for the matters addressed herein. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or her designee. The penalty payment shall be submitted to the following address:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not


addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Section 49-17-31 (Rev. 2003), and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
