COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Gulf South Pipeline Company, LP, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

By letter dated September 9, 2015, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations identified during a review of Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) for the fourth quarter of 2014 regarding its hydrostatic testing locations in Macedonia, Mississippi in Forrest County; Stafford Springs, Mississippi in Jasper County; and Moss Point, Mississippi in Jackson County.

Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.

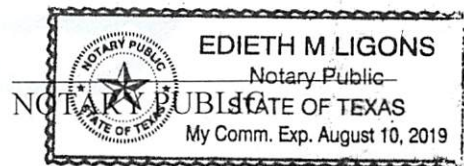
