AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Columbus Christian Academy, Inc., Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letters dated February 8, 2016, March 2, 2017, and June 13, 2017, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations at its facility located at 6405 Military Road, Steens, Mississippi in Lowndes County:

- A. Violation of NPDES Permit MS0054232. Respondent failed to comply with the Fecal Coliform Monthly Average effluent limitations for 2015 and 2016.
- B. Violation of NPDES Permit MS0054232. Respondent failed to comply with the Fecal Coliform Daily Maximum effluent limitations for 2015 and 2016.
- C. Violation of NPDES Permit MS0054232. Permit Condition T-24, Proper Operation, Maintenance and Replacement.
 - 1. The structures around the lagoon needed to be repaired or replaced.
 - 2. The lagoon dikes needed clearing around the water's edge.

On February 7, 2018, Respondent submitted documentation via email asserting that all violations have been addressed, and that the facility is now in compliance.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000. Respondent shall pay \$2,500 to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee (the "Execution Date"). Respondent shall pay the remaining balance of \$2,500 on or before July 31, 2018. The settlement payments shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
