AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Kim Lee, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

On May 1, 2018, Complainant issued Administrative Order No. 6848 18 ("the Order") to the Respondent for the following violations at the Klee mining site located by Ridge Road in Section 35, Township 6S, Range 17W, Pearl River County, Mississippi ("the Site"):

- A. Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-29, 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 6, Ch. 1, and the Code of Federal Regulations at 40 CFR 122.26 (b) (14) (iii), regarding the operation of a surface mine without the required Storm Water Permit coverage;
- B. Miss. Code Ann. § 53-7-1 et seq. and 11 Miss. Admin. Code Pt. 8, Ch. 1 regarding the operation of a surface mine without a Mining Permit.

The Order required Respondent, in part, cease and desist further mining at the Site. Prior to resuming operations, Respondent was required to install and implement necessary storm water controls, obtain all necessary permits and county zoning approval for operating the Site, and resolve

Respondent submitted a Surface Mining and Reclamation Permit application to the Office of Geology and a Mining Storm Water Notice of Intent, including a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan, to the Office of Pollution Control on February 27, 2018.

2.

Complainant and Respondent agree to settle the civil enforcement requirement of Administrative Order No. 6848 18 as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$15,750.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

4.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver

of that right.
