AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Interim Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Goodloe Construction Co., LLC, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated February 14, 2020, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations of Mining Storm Water Permit Coverage No. MSR322717 at its mining operation located on Pisgah Bottom Road, Canton, Mississippi in Madison County:

- A. Violation of ACT4 Condition S-3 (1-3): Failure to submit a Major Modification Form for project expansion.
- B. Violation of ACT6 Condition S-1 (1): Failure to implement the SWPPP.
- C. Violation of ACT6 Condition S-1 (2): Failure to implement BMPs.
- D. Violation of ACT6 S-1 (5) Failure to amend the SWPPP.
- E. Violation of ACT6 S-3: Failure to mark boundaries.

Section 301 of the Trade Act of 1974 provides that the Commission shall investigate the foreign country or origin of the product of any article of foreign origin the importation of which is being or about to be restricted by the United States Government.

The Commission is currently conducting an investigation of the foreign country or origin of the product of any article of foreign origin the importation of which is being or about to be restricted by the United States Government.

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F. Violation of ACT7 S-1: Failure to perform monthly inspections.

By letter dated March 6, 2020, Respondent ceased mining operation and has begun the process of reclaiming the property. Upon completion of reclamation activities, Respondent will request termination of Coverage No. MSR322717 under Mississippi's Mining Storm Water General Permit to discharge storm water associated with the mining of Goodloe Mine.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

- A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,737.50. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
