AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Duraco, Inc., Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated June 23, 2020, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations of Mississippi's Baseline Storm Water General NPDES Permit (Coverage No. MSR001460) at its facility located at 2000 Old Whitfield Road, Pearl, Mississippi in Rankin County:

- A. Violation of Act 5, Condition T-3(4): Failure to maintain Monthly Spill and Leak Log.
- B. Violation of Act 5, Condition T-7(8): Failure to maintain Illicit Connection Certification.
- C. Violation of Act 5, Condition T-8(9): Failure to conduct Monthly Inspections and Jar Tests.
- D. Violation of Act 7, Condition S-1(4): Failure to amend the SWPPP.
- E. Violation of Act 8, Condition S-2: Failure to conduct Annual Site Inspection and

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SWPPP Evaluation.

F. Violation of Act 12, Condition S-2: Failure to conduct Annual Training.

By email dated June 30, 2020 and letter dated October 15, 2020, the Respondent asserts the facility has returned to compliance with Mississippi's Baseline Storm Water General NPDES Permit (Coverage No. MSR001460).

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

- A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,425.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.
