AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Gene Stock Construction, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated December 4, 2020, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violation at its Vacant Land Project located at 15034 North Swan Road, Gulfport, Mississippi in Harrison County:

Violation of MS Code Ann. 49-17-29(2b): which states in part that "...it is unlawful for any person to carry on any of the following activities, unless that person holds a current permit for that activity from the Permit Board as may be required for the disposal of all wastes which are or may be discharged into the waters of the state... (iii) the construction, installation or operation of any industrial, commercial or other establishment, including irrigation projects or any extension or modification thereof or addition thereto, the operation of which would cause an increase in the discharge of wastes into the waters of the state..."

Respondent failed to obtain coverage under Mississippi's Large Construction Storm Water General Permit before the commencement of construction activities at the site.

On November 30, 2020, MDEQ's Environmental Permits Division received a Large Construction Notice of Intent for coverage under the Large Construction General Permit for Gene Stock Construction, Vacant Land Project. The Notice of Intent is under review.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violation listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

A. Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$7,350.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director or his designee. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 49-17-31, and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
