AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and ITT Engineered Valves, LLC, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated April 17, 2012, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following violations at its facility located at 1110 Bankhead Avenue, Amory, Mississippi in Monroe County:

Condition S-2 of the Synthetic Minor Operating Permit 1840-00066

Except as otherwise specified herein, the permittee shall Submit a certified annual synthetic minor monitoring report: Due annually, by the 31st of January for preceding calendar year. This report shall address any required monitoring specified in the permit. This report shall provide

(a) the identification of each coating, adhesive, solvent or other VOC or HAP containing material used; (b) the VOC and HAP content(s) of each coating, adhesive, solvent or other VOC or HAP containing material used; (c) the total gallons of each coating, adhesive, solvent or other VOC or HAP containing material used in any consecutive (or rolling) 12-month period; and (d) the total VOC emission rate, the emission rate of each individual HAP and the total HAP emission rate in tons per month and TPY for any consecutive (or rolling) 12-month period. [APC-S-2 II.B(11)]

The Respondent's annual monitoring report for 2011 was submitted late. It was due on January

31, 2012; Respondent voluntarily self-reported this violation by letter dated April 11, 2012; Complainant received the report on April 16, 2012.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the violation listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the amount of \$7,000. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within forty-five (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Section 49-17-31 (Rev. 2003), and that it
