### AGREED ORDER

COME NOW the Mississippi Commission on Environmental Quality (Commission), acting through the staff and Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Complainant, and Nidec Motor Corporation, Respondent, in the above captioned cause and agree as follows:

1.

By letter dated March 6, 2012, Respondent was contacted by Complainant and notified of the following alleged violations at its facility located at 710 Venture Drive, Suite 100, Southaven, Mississippi in Desoto County:

A. An apparent violation of air Synthetic Minor Operating Permit No. 0680-00101 (the "Permit), condition I.8, which requires that, for renewal of the permit, the applicant shall make application not less that one-hundred eighty (180) days prior to the expiration date of the permit substantiated with current emission data, test results or reports or other data as deemed necessary by the Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board. The renewal application for the Respondent's air permit was not received until after the permit expired. The

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permit expired on February 28, 2012, and the application was submitted on or about March 23, 2012.

B. An apparent violation of Commission regulation AP-S-2, I.D.1 which requires a state permit to operate for synthetic minor sources, major Title V sources, and significant minor sources. Due to the expiration of the Permit, Respondent has operated without a valid air operating permit since February 28, 2012.

2.

In lieu of a formal enforcement hearing concerning the alleged violations listed above, Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter as follows:

Respondent agrees to pay and Complainant agrees to accept a civil penalty in the Α. amount of \$15,000.00. Respondent shall pay this penalty to MDEQ within fortyfive (45) days after this Agreed Order has been executed by the MDEQ Executive Director. The settlement payment shall be submitted to:

Until the Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board or its designee acts on В. the renewal application for Respondent's Permit, Respondent shall comply with the terms and conditions of Synthetic Minor Operating Permit 0680-00101 issued October 8, 2010.

3.

Nothing in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission in the event Respondent fails to comply with this Agreed Order. The Agreed Order shall be strictly construed to apply to those matters expressly resolved herein.

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4.

Nothing contained in this Agreed Order shall limit the rights of MDEQ or the Commission to take enforcement or other actions against Respondent for violations not addressed herein and for future violations of environmental laws, rules, and regulations.

5.

Respondent understands and acknowledges that it is entitled to an evidentiary hearing before the Commission pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. Section 49-17-31 (Rev. 2003), and that it has made an informed waiver of that right.
