INSTRUCTIONS

The Hydrostatic Test Notice of Intent (HTNOI) is for coverage under the Hydrostatic Test General Permit to discharge hydrostatic test water and storm water associated with land disturbing activities of one (1) acre or greater; or for land disturbing activities, which are part of a larger common plan of development or sale that are initially less than one (1) acre but will ultimately disturb one (1) or more acres. Applicant must be the owner or operator. The coverage recipient is responsible for compliance with the conditions of the general permit.

Completed HTNOIs should be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of regulated activity. Discharge of hydrostatic test water or storm water from regulated construction activities without written notification of coverage is a violation of state law.

A USGS quadrangle map or copy is a required submittal. The map shall extend at least one-half of a mile beyond the facility/ project property boundary. In the case of linear pipeline projects the map shall extend at least one-half of a mile beyond the pipeline right-of-way. The site location and outfalls must be outlined and labeled. Quad maps can be obtained from the Office of Geology (601-961-5523). If a copy is submitted, provide the name of the quadrangle map that is found in upper right hand corner.

Additional submittals may include the following:

- A site-specific Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) developed in accordance with ACT8 of the General Permit, if the project includes regulated construction activity disturbing five (5) acres or more
- A description of proposed water treatment additives as outlined in ACT4, S-4 of the General Permit
- Appropriate Section 404 documentation from U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- Written authorization from the MDEQ, Office of Land and Water, if water withdrawal from surface waters or ground waters is to be used for the testing. For information call the Office of Land and Water at 601/961-5202

INSTRUCTIONS

In accordance with ACT10, R-3 of the Hydrostatic Test General Permit, notification shall be submitted to MDEQ regarding the start date/time and anticipated duration of the surface discharge of hydrostatic test water from the subject project. 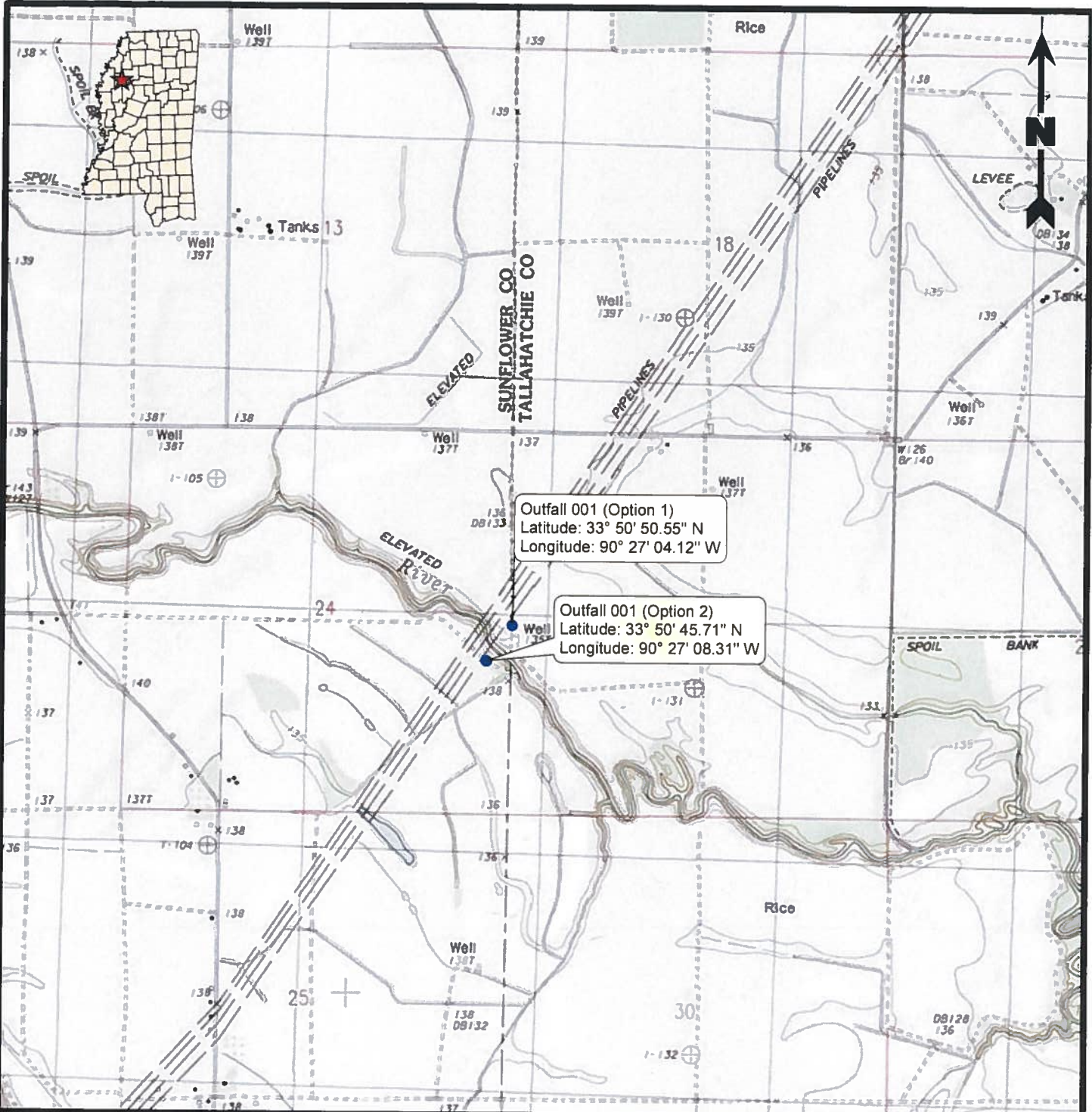

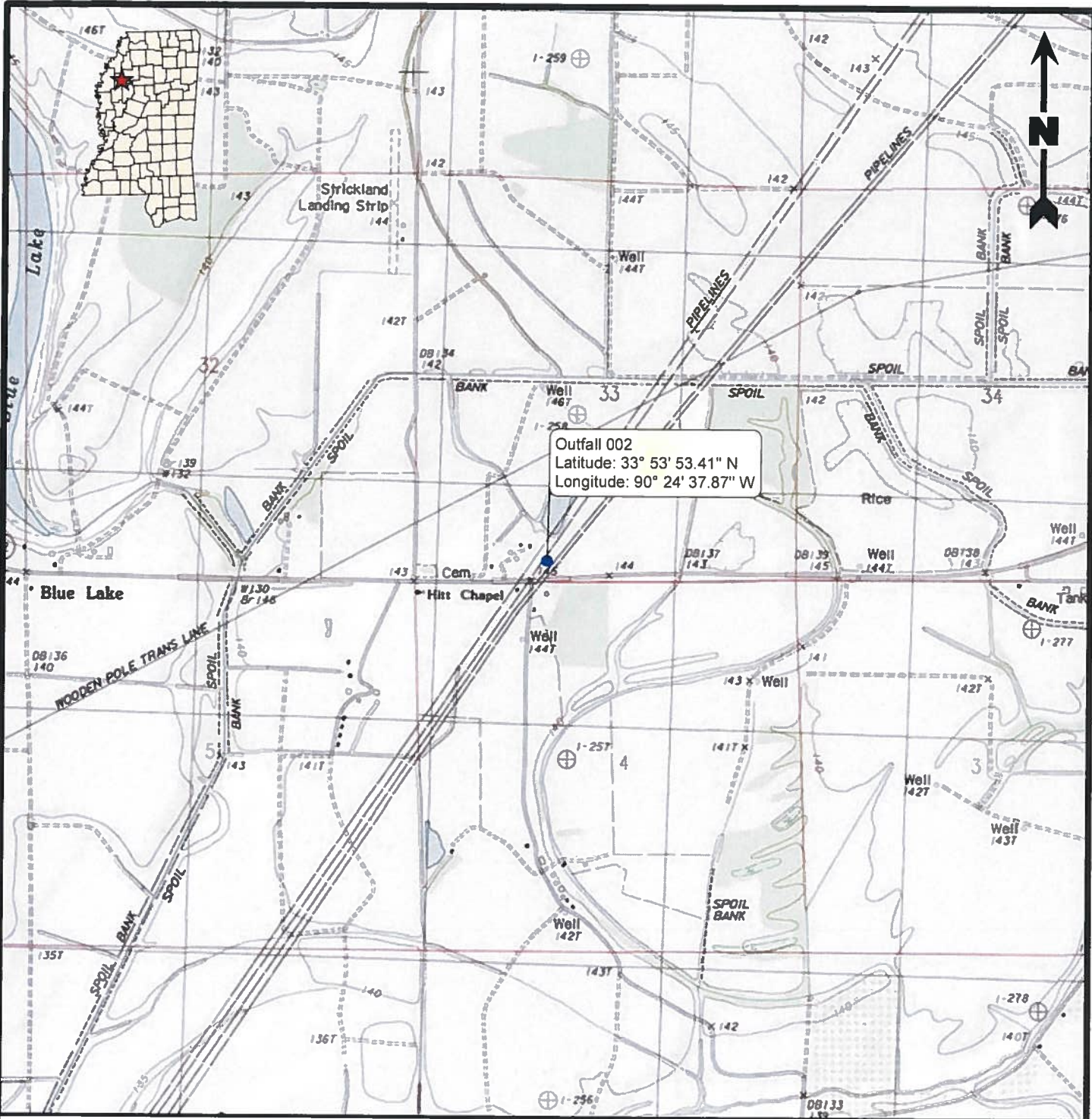

To Whom It May Concern:

On behalf of Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (TGP), Providence is submitting this Hydrostatic Test Notice of Intent (HTNOI) requesting authorization for a discharge of hydrostatic test water from their existing 30-inch-diameter natural gas pipeline (Outfall 001) in Sunflower County, Mississippi and their Cassidy Trap Site (Outfall 002) in Tallahatchie County, Mississippi. The volume of water at Outfall 001 will be approximately 17,000 gallons from a municipal source or agriculture well and discharged at a rate of 50 gallons-per-minute onto their existing right-of-way. The volume of water at Outfall 002 will be approximately 10,000 gallons from a nearby pond and discharged at a rate of 50 gallons-per-minute.

Please find attached the topographic maps showing the discharge locations (**Figures 1 and 2**) and the HTNOI general permit forms and requisite supporting information (**Attachment A**). Providence respectfully requests that your office review the attached form and provide the requisite clearance for this activity.
