**MINING NOTICE OF INTENT (MNOI)
FOR COVERAGE UNDER
MINING STORM WATER, DEWATERING AND NO DISCHARGE
GENERAL PERMIT MSR32 2870
(Number to be assigned by State)**

File at least 30 days prior to the commencement of mining; 15 days if a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is already on file and mine dewatering is not proposed. Lateral expansion of an existing mine that has general permit coverage requires the submittal of the Major Modification Form, not a new MNOI. However, modification of the existing SWPPP to include the expansion is required. Discharge of storm water or impounded water associated with mining or the operation of a wastewater recirculation system with no discharge without written notification of coverage from MDEQ is a violation of State Law.

If the company seeking coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of this coverage form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

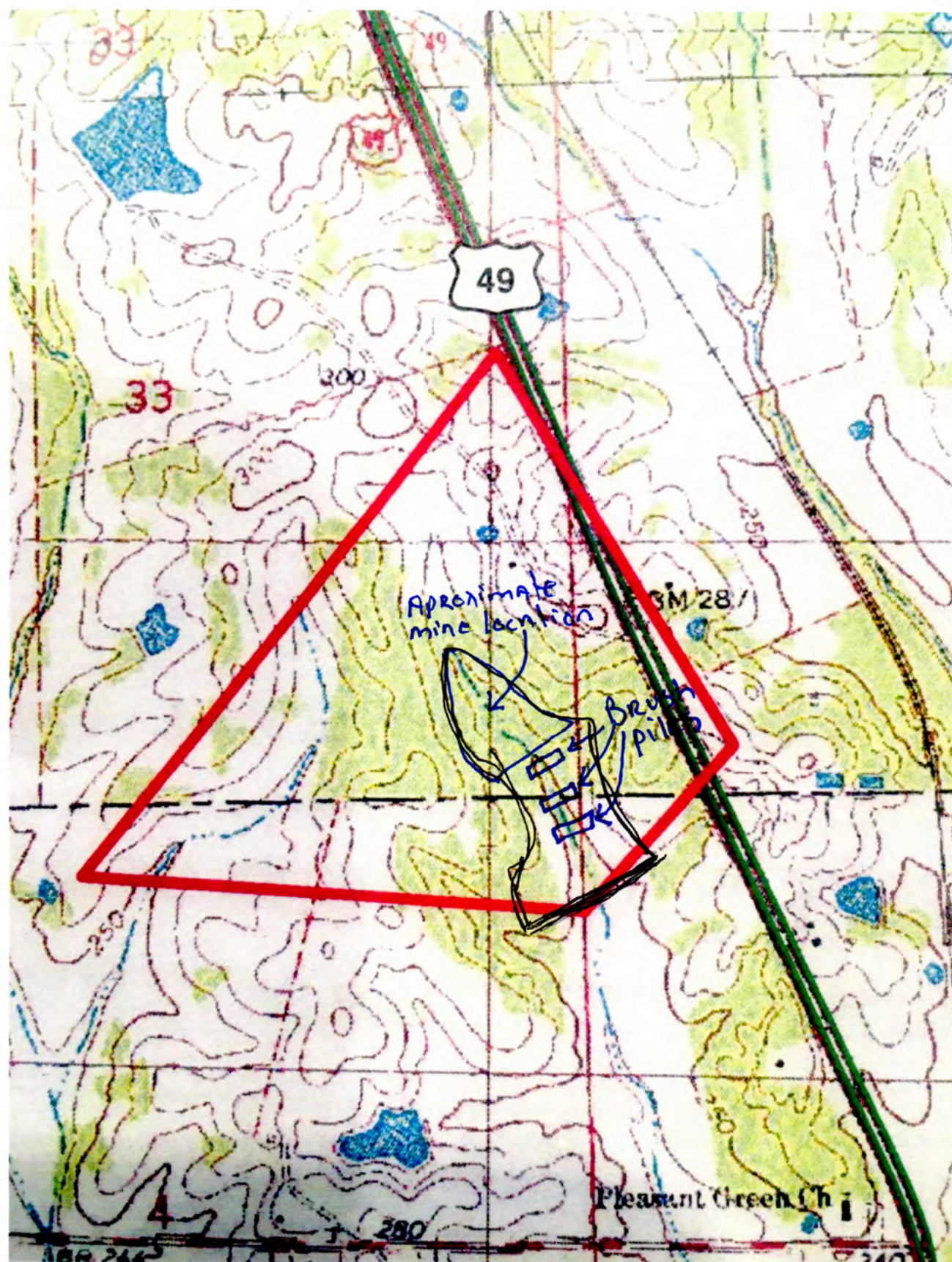

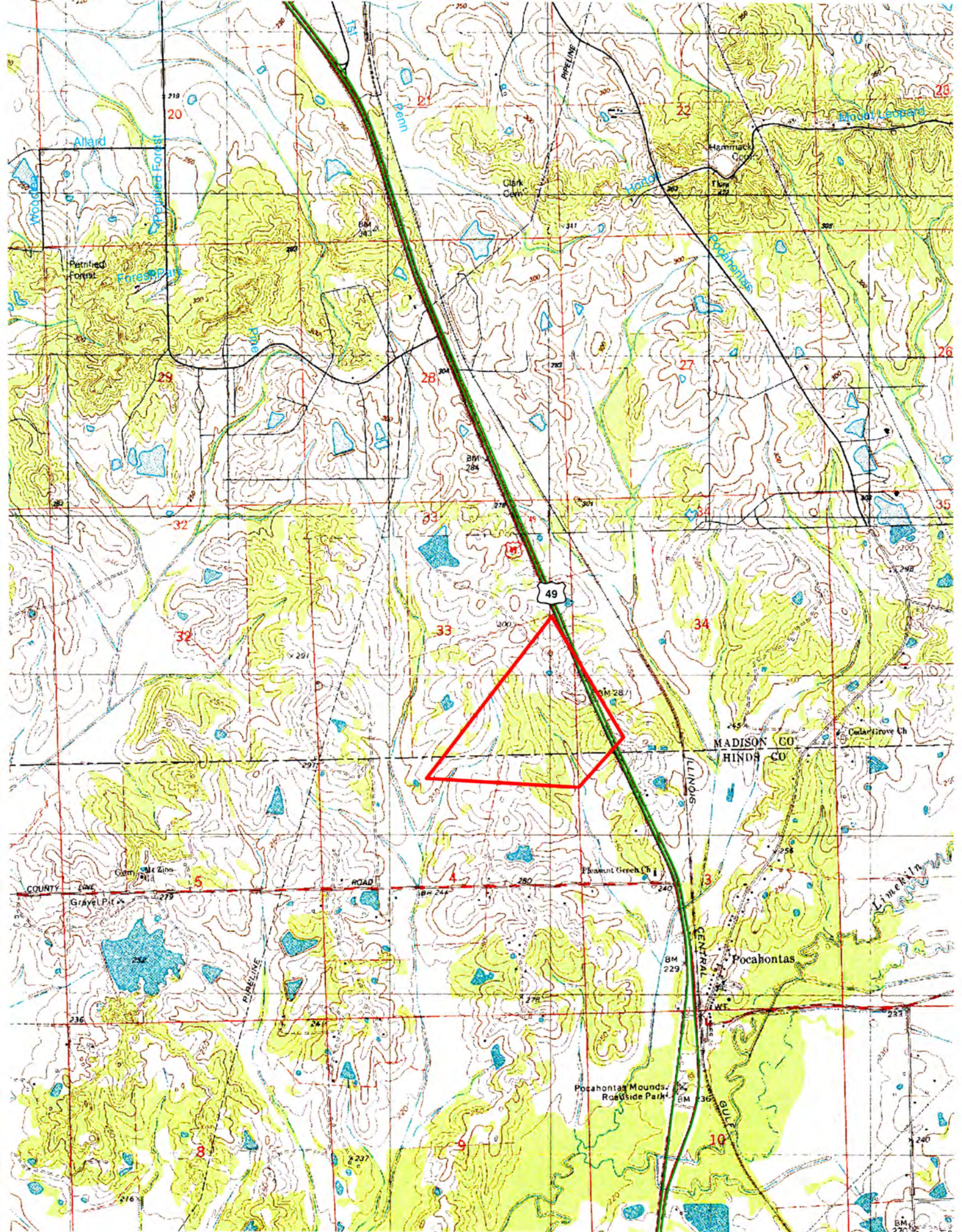

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your Notice of Exempt Operation received on May 20, 2020. **In the event this operation exceeds four (4) acres, you will be required to obtain a state mining permit.**

In addition to a Notice of Exempt Operation, you must apply for and obtain coverage under a Mining Storm Water General NPDES Permit prior to any mining activities at this site. Operating without a Storm Water Permit is a violation of the Mississippi State Law, Sections 49-17-1 through 49-17-43, which provides for significant monetary penalties. Storm Water Prevention Plan

We have an existing lake bed with the majority of dam structure in place. The original dam was constructed approximately 20 years ago. Unfortunately, the dam blew out in the center.

It is now our desire to dig out the upper end of the lake bed in order to add depth to lake bed and improve acre feet of water. The lake bed is currently in natural vegetation.

We would propose a series of brush piles in the lake bed strategically placed to prevent erosion and create sediment control. The downstream area is covered with undisturbed natural vegetation and the downstream property line is located 1800 +or- feet from the mining location.

The public road access will be rocked and maintained for 150 +or- feet to prevent dirt and/or debris from being on public road.
