



The SWPPP must comply with the requirements of ACT 5 of the RMCGP. If an electronic copy is submitted, a hard copy should also be mailed to the address above for MDEQ's files.

Wastewater Treatment: If wastewater treatment facilities are necessary to achieve compliance with the terms of the RMCGP, the plans and specifications for such treatment facilities must be submitted with the NOI>

Public Notice / Contiguous Landowner Notification: If the proposed facility will be considered a synthetic minor source, the applicant must publish a public notice allowing 30 days for receipt of public comments. For ALL proposed facilities, the applicant must provide contiguous landowner notification. The public notice and contiguous landowner notification form are available online at www.mdeq.ms.gov/rmcgp. A copy of the public notice and/or contiguous landowner notification form(s) must be submitted with the NOI.

Storm Water from Construction Activities: The RMCGP no longer covers storm water from construction activities. Construction activities including clearing, excavating, and other land disturbing activities equal to or greater than one (1) acre but less than five (5) acres require compliance with the Small Construction General Permit and completion of a Small Construction Notice of Intent (SCNOI). Construction activities equal to or greater than five (5) acres require compliance with the Large Construction General Permit and submittal of a Large Construction Notice of Intent (LCNOI).
