Gentlemen:

This is in response to your comment letter dated March 24, 2022, and to provide supporting documentation for purposes of securing MDEQ Water Quality Certification for the above referenced. Enclosed for reference is one (1) set of the drainage construction plans of the above referenced which includes the post-construction elevations, design grades and outfall structure details along with the drainage analysis, detention basin calculations, run-off rates and return time calculations in Appendix A of the detention basin calculations. While the numerous grass swales incorporated into the design of the project will certainly function to enhance the quality of the surface drainage run-off, the primary source of treatment are the oversized detention basins.

The detention basins are sized based on an average estimated 3,500 sf of impervious surface area per lot. Note that the basin volumes well exceed the minimum required volume for the first 1 ½" rain as seen in the attached Detention Basin Geometrics Table. Additionally, Appendix A of the detention basin calculations shows that the outfall structures drain half of the first 1 ½" volume within 48 to 72 hours with no more than half the volume being discharged within 48 hours.

The construction plans have been carefully designed to incorporate measures to minimize potential secondary impacts to the avoided wetlands. The construction plans provide, to the maximum extent practicable, for virtually all preserved non-impacted wetlands to be situated outside of the individual privately owned lots. Significant portions, if not all, of the preserved wetland areas will be designated as 'common areas' and dedicated as 'drainage easements' to the local municipality. This simple but sure solution should virtually eliminate any potential 'meddling' with wetlands that could eventually result in adversely affecting the quantity of surface drainage in the avoided wetlands and, hence, maintain the integrity of the surface and subsurface hydrology of the

avoided wetlands.

The potential of individual lot owners causing secondary impacts to the avoided wetlands is only associated with a small portion of the lots in the proposed development. Certain mechanisms will be implemented in an effort to prevent the individual owners of these lots from potentially causing secondary impacts to the avoided wetlands. These consist of specifying in the covenants of the Home Owners Association that areas of avoided and preserved wetlands are to remain undisturbed and providing physical demarcation on the ground not only in the form of property corners and fencing but also with the installation of 'Warning Wetlands' placards to be placed along the edge of the avoided wetlands.

Centralized water and wastewater utility service is being provided by the Harrison County Utility Authority (HCUA). Additionally, the utility infrastructure installed for this project will be owned, operated and maintained by the HCUA, perpetually. A copy of the 'Will Serve' letter is also attached for your records.

Finally, submitted as an attachment hereto is the Large Construction Notice of Intent (LCNOI) Form for review and approval to procure the necessary Large Construction Storm Water General Permit (NPDES Permit MSR10) approval.

LARGE CONSTRUCTION NOTICE OF INTENT (LCNOI) FOR COVERAGE UNDER THE LARGE CONSTRUCTION STORM WATER GENERAL NPDES PERMIT

INSTRUCTIONS

The Large Construction Notice of Intent (LCNOI) is for coverage under the Large Construction General Permit for land disturbing activities of five (5) acres or greater; or for land disturbing activities, which are part of a larger common plan of development or sale that are initially less than five (5) acres but will ultimately disturb five (5) or more acres. Applicant must be the owner or operator. For construction activities, the operator is typically the prime contractor. The owner(s) of the property and the prime contractor associated with regulated construction activity on the property have joint and severable responsibility for compliance with the Large Construction Storm Water General Permit MSR10.

If the company seeking coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of this coverage form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

Completed LCNOIs should be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of construction. Discharge of storm water from large construction activities without written notification of coverage is a violation of state law.

Submittals with this LCNOI must include:

- A site-specific Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) developed in accordance with ACT5 of the General Permit
- · A detailed site-specific scaled drawing showing the property layout and the features outlined in ACT5 of the General Permit
- A United States Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle map or photocopy, extending at least one-half mile beyond the facility property boundaries with the site location and outfalls outlined or highlighted. The name of the quadrangle map must be shown on all copies. Quadrangle maps can be obtained from the MDEQ, Office of Geology at 601-961-5523.

Additional submittals may include the following, if applicable:

- · Appropriate Section 404 documentation from U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- · Appropriate documentation concerning future disposal of sanitary sewage and sewage collection system construction
- Appropriate documentation from the MDEQ Office of Land & Water concerning dam construction and low flow requirements
- · Approval from County Utility Authority in Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl River and Stone Counties
