**MINING NOTICE OF INTENT (MNOI)
FOR COVERAGE UNDER
MINING STORM WATER, DEWATERING AND NO DISCHARGE
GENERAL PERMIT MSR323021

File at least 30 days prior to the commencement of mining; 15 days if a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is already on file and mine dewatering is not proposed. Lateral expansion of an existing mine that has general permit coverage requires the submittal of the Major Modification Form, not a new MNOI. However, modification of the existing SWPPP to include the expansion is required. Discharge of storm water or impounded water associated with mining or the operation of a wastewater recirculation system with no discharge without written notification of coverage from MDEQ is a violation of State Law.

If the company seeking coverage is a corporation, a limited liability company, a partnership, or a business trust, attach proof of its registration with the Mississippi Secretary of State and/or its Certificate of Good Standing. This registration or Certificate of Good Standing must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of the submittal of this coverage form. Coverage will be issued in the company name as it is registered with the Mississippi Secretary of State.

RE: Dirt Plus, LLC – Saussy Pit Mine Road

Dear Michelle,

Based on the site inspection completed, there is an existing road traversing the mine property from West to East with existing culvert crossings at locations specified in the enclosed report.

The road appears to have existed since approximately 2013 and currently allows access to the entire property. Any required maintenance of the existing road structures, including culverts, would need to be completed within the existing roadway. The removal of accumulated sediment in order to improve water flow within the stream may be completed within the vicinity of the existing road structures (culverts) not to exceed 200 linear feet from the structures. Any removed sediment should be deposited in uplands. Erosion control measures should be implemented at crossings to minimize additional sedimentation into wetlands and/or streams.

It is the opinion of Wetland Consulting Services, Inc. that continued use of the existing roadway, without expanding into adjacent wetlands, would not require additional Section 404 permitting for the purpose of obtaining a Mining General Permit from MDEQ.
