If the project is complete and final stabilization has been achieved, please request termination of coverage by completing the Request for Termination (RFT) Form found in the Large Construction Forms Package. Projects that continue to discharge storm water associated with construction activity without applicable permit coverage are in violation of state law.

SWPPP AMENDMENT FOR RECOVERAGE PACKAGE LARGE CONSTRUCTION SWPPP GENERAL PERMIT (MSR10) MOSELLE REPOWER PROJECT

PURPOSE:

The Permit Board on Environmental Quality reissued the Large Construction Storm Water General Permit (MSR10) for construction activities on January 11, 2011. This general permit authorizes the discharge of storm water from construction sites that disturb five (5) or more acres by clearing, grading, excavating, or other land disturbing activities. This permit replaces the previous general permit that expired on May 31, 2010 and was administratively extended by MDEQ. The permit is reissued for a five-year period that will end on December 31, 2015. Coverage recipients wishing to be covered under the reissued general permit must submit a Re-coverage Form within 30-days of the date of the Letter of Instruction that will be mailed to active coverage holders. All construction projects that currently have Large Construction General Permit coverage should receive a Re-coverage Package containing the Letter of Instruction, an Addendum summarizing significant permit changes, and the Re-coverage Form. The Letter of Instruction will be dated January 21, 2011.

RESPONSE:

South Mississippi Electric Power Association received the SMEPA Moselle Re-Power Project Letter of Instruction via email on March 24, 2011. The Re-Coverage Form Instructions on Page 1 of 2 do not require submittal of the SWPPP amendments for the sole intent of incorporating the new permit conditions. However, the Re-Coverage Form on Page 2 of 2 does require the SWPPP to be in compliance with five specific conditions in order to receive recoverage. In order to meet these two of the five specific conditions on Page 2 of 2, this amendment was drafted and will be added to the SMEPA Moselle Re-Power Project SWPPP and any applicable copies.

 - Page 4-1(a) will be added to SWPPP detailing the requirements of ACT2, T-3 (3)

 - Page 3-3(a) will be added to SWPPP detailing the requirements of ACT5, T-4 (1)

SWPPP AMENDMENT FOR RECOVERAGE PACKAGE LARGE CONSTRUCTION SWPPP GENERAL PERMIT (MSR10) MOSELLE REPOWER PROJECT

The following non-storm water discharges are prohibited in accordance with ACT2, T-3(3):

- (A) Wastewater from washout of concrete (unless managed by an appropriate control)
- (B) Wastewater from washout and cleanout of stucco, paint, form release oils, curing compounds and other construction materials
- (C) Fuels, oils, or other pollutants used in vehicle and equipment operation and maintenance
- (D) Soaps or solvents used in vehicle and equipment washing
- (E) Wastewater from sanitary facilities, including portable toilets

SWPPP AMENDMENT FOR RECOVERAGE PACKAGE LARGE CONSTRUCTION SWPPP GENERAL PERMIT (MSR10) MOSELLE REPOWER PROJECT

Vegetative Practices shall be designed to preserve existing vegetation where feasible and initiate vegetative stabilization measures after land disturbing activities. Such practices may include, but not limited to, temporary seeding, permanent seeding, mulching, sod stabilization, vegetative buffer strips, tree protection and topsoil preservation.

Soil stabilization-vegetative stabilization measures must be initiated whenever any clearing, grading, excavating or other land disturbing activities have temporarily or permanently ceased on any portion of the site and will not resume for a period of fourteen (14) days or more. The appropriate temporary or permanent vegetative practices shall be implemented with seven (7) calendar days.
